Overview

Before using CLP in the classroom, run through the *Initial Setup Documentation* and *Notebook Setup Documentation*. Each time it's used, the CLP application will need to be started on the teacher, projector, and student computers. Once the teacher opens a notebook, the projector and student computers will automatically connect to the teacher computer (and will not display pages until they can connect to a teacher computer with a CLP notebook open). When connected to the teacher computer, the projector computer will mirror the teacher computer (see **Projector Guidelines** in the *Teacher Features Documentation*), and each student computer will have the teacher's selected pages (session) loaded.

Instructions

Teacher computer

1. Tap the **CLP icon** on the top left corner.
2. From **Open** from the left menu bar, select a class roster file, notebook, teacher name.
3. Tap **Open Session**.

Projector computer simply needs to launch CLP.

Student computers

Students log into CLP by choosing his/her name on the startup screen.

If a student chooses a name that is already logged in, he or she will not be able to log in until the other student restarts CLP. Names are displayed on the top right corner.
